



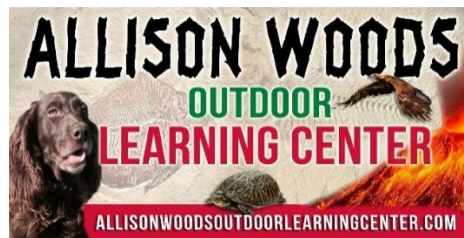
WORLD FALCONRY DAY
